June 16-20, Introductory Forest Mycology, Siskiyou Field Institute, Ashland area: Course taught by **Dan Luoma, PhD.** The course provides an overview of forest mycology with emphasis on the ecology and identification of ectomycorrhizal fungi as well as issues surrounding commercially harvested fungi, decomposer and pathogenic fungi. Background in biological sciences useful but not necessary. Class

format includes lecture, lab and field trips. Tuition is \$185. Tuition does not include lodging. The Siskiyou Field Institute has reserved camping and lodging for participants as well as information about other accommodations. November 11 and 12 (beginners) or November 13 and 14 (intermediate), Fall Fruiterers I & II: Mycology in Southwest Oregon, Siskiyou Field Institute: Course taught by Eric McEwen and CMS member **Ron Hamill.** The beginner's course focuses on skills needed to use identification keys, and the intermediate course continues with more advanced skills. Course includes alternating field (foray into the Siskiyou slopes near Wagner Butte) and lab sessions. Tuition is \$90 for one class or \$180 for both.
